We are seeking a qualified Cambodian candidate to fill in the position of **Student Development Officer and Life Skills Trainer** to be based in Battambang province.

Position Summary:

The Student Development Officer and Life Skills Trainer will work under the direct supervision of the Social Support Manager. This position requires a good command of English and Khmer to handle material translations. The candidate must have real life experience of application of life skills and be familiar with active learning strategies to impart life skills in an engaging manner adapted to the learning styles of the students.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Research and develop life skills & soft skills programs incorporating relevant activities.
- Conduct life skills and soft skills trainings using active learning principals adjusted to the students learning styles.
- Assess and report on students' learning and performance for the life skills programs.
- Develop and provide individualized training support for struggling students.
- Assist with the supervision of in-school and out-of-school student activities.
- Assist with student recreational activities.
- Create an integrated student development plan incorporating training, student run activities, clubs etc. where theory can be practiced.
- Provide appropriate encouragement and positive reinforcement for students.
- Encourage student independence and the development of unique talents of individual students.
- Show understanding for each student family situation so that appropriate support can be provided.
- Collect student results every semester.
- Develop a professional working relationship with teachers and coordinate to integrate life skills and soft skills principals into regular class curriculum and behavioral expectations.
- Participate in Education and Career Development meetings, events, and other community meetings as required.
- Work closely, if necessary with government authorities, such as provincial, public school and ministry of education.
- To be knowledgeable of school mission, procedures and policies.
- Support with other tasks as may be assigned by the Social Support Manager.

- Possess knowledge in Pedagogy
- At least 2 years of experience working in the area of training
- Computer literacy (MS Office, in particular)
- Good knowledge of English both speaking and writing
- Good organizational skills
- Strong communications skills
- Problem solving skills.
