Main duties and responsibilities

The Product & Graphic Designer will design products for the Ponleu Selpak Boutique from initial idea to final production. Typical projects will include T-shirts, hoodies, water bottles, booklets, scarves, posters, and other materials. The candidate will learn and work first-hand with how souvenirs and gifts are conceived, designed, produced, and packaged for final sale. The candidate will work in the Development & Communications department.

Day-to-day activities

- Developing concepts, graphics, and layouts within the Ponleu Selpak brand identity and according to briefings from the Development & Communications Managers.
- Determining the size and arrangement of illustrative material and copy, font style, and size according to the boutique visual style guide.
- Updating existing boutique materials, products, and signage.
- Coordinating the printing and production process for all products. (Training provided.)
- Occasional graphic design projects for other Communications Team projects
